## Spring Outing ~ 2017



Bill's exceptional talent for glass and especially mushroom photography are well known to members who regularly attend our meetings. Bill, along with former club president Adele Shelton, were co-leaders of the club for many years. Bill was an early innovator in the NCCT and would regularly come up with creative assignments and photo scavenger hunts for club members to complete and share at the monthly club meetings. He gave many talks, gladly shared his photos (many in vibrant print form), and was always willing to talk photography and photo equipment with anyone who wanted to chat. He was also well know for an annual slide show of his nature photography that he combined with narrative poetry that he composed himself. Bill was a U.S. Army veteran, Boy Scout Leader and worked for Brown Motors in Toledo for 50 years. He leaves to cherish his memory his loving wife of 70 years, Violet; children, Vicky Coombs and Bill Blanton, three siblings and several grand, great-grand, and great-great grand children, as well as many loving nieces and nephews.
